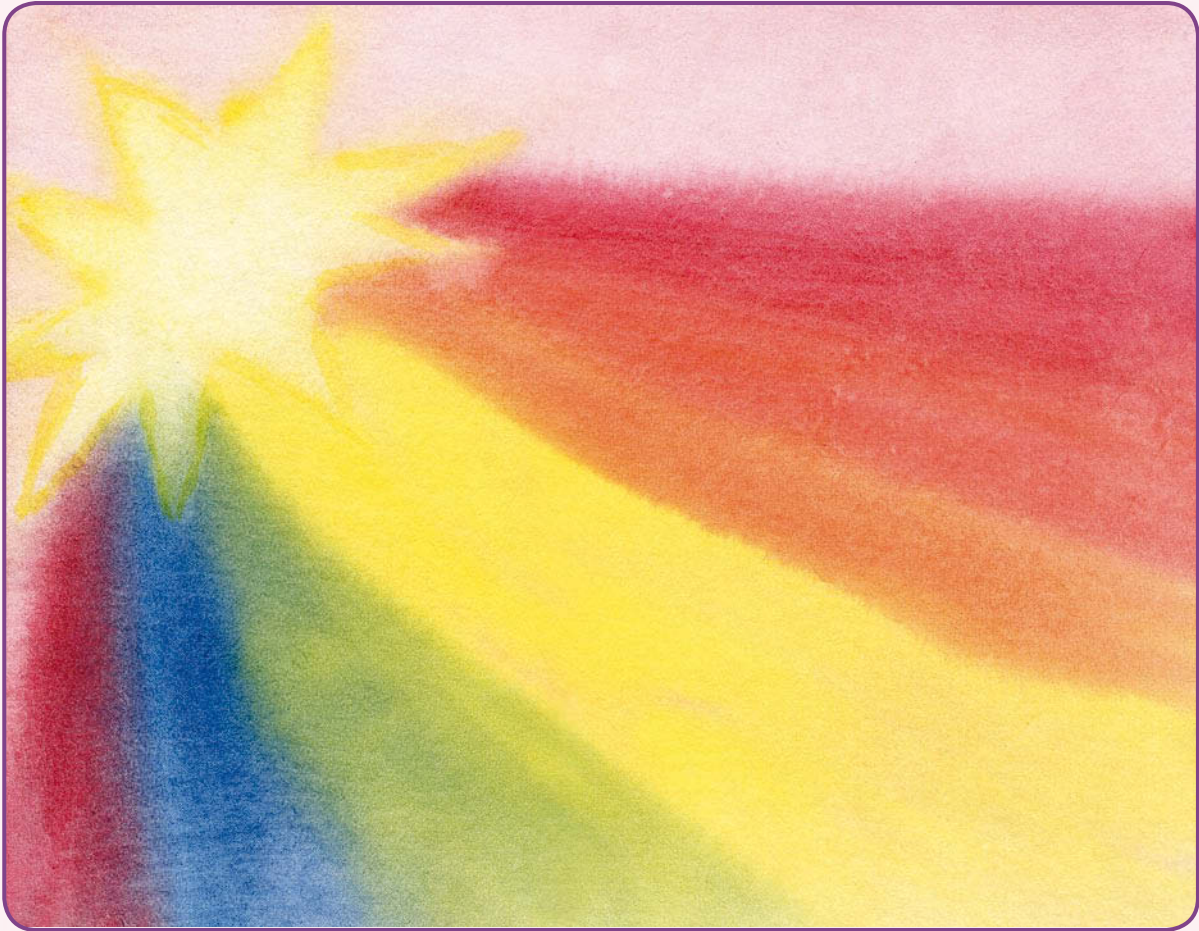

Morning Bright

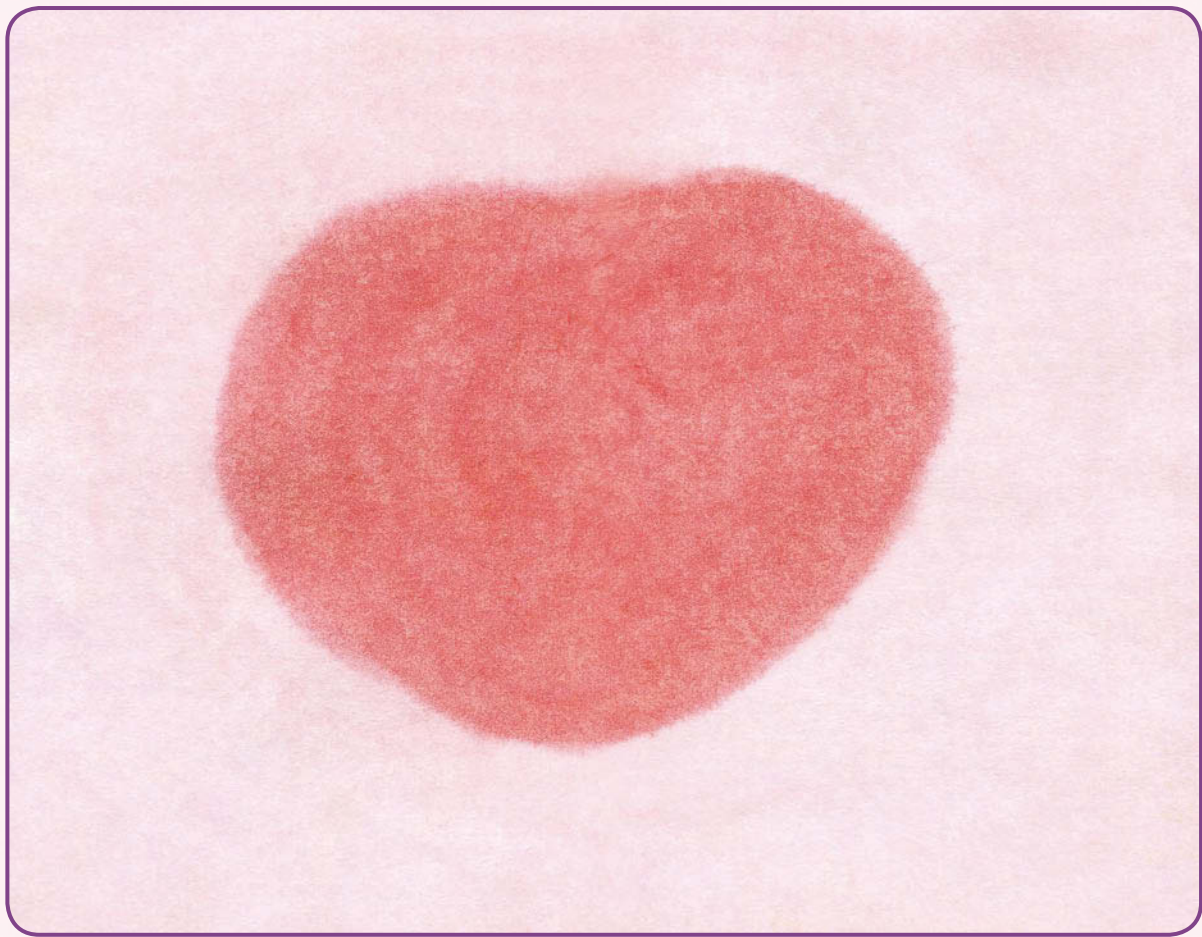
Down to earth the colors glide



over the Rainbow they like to slide.



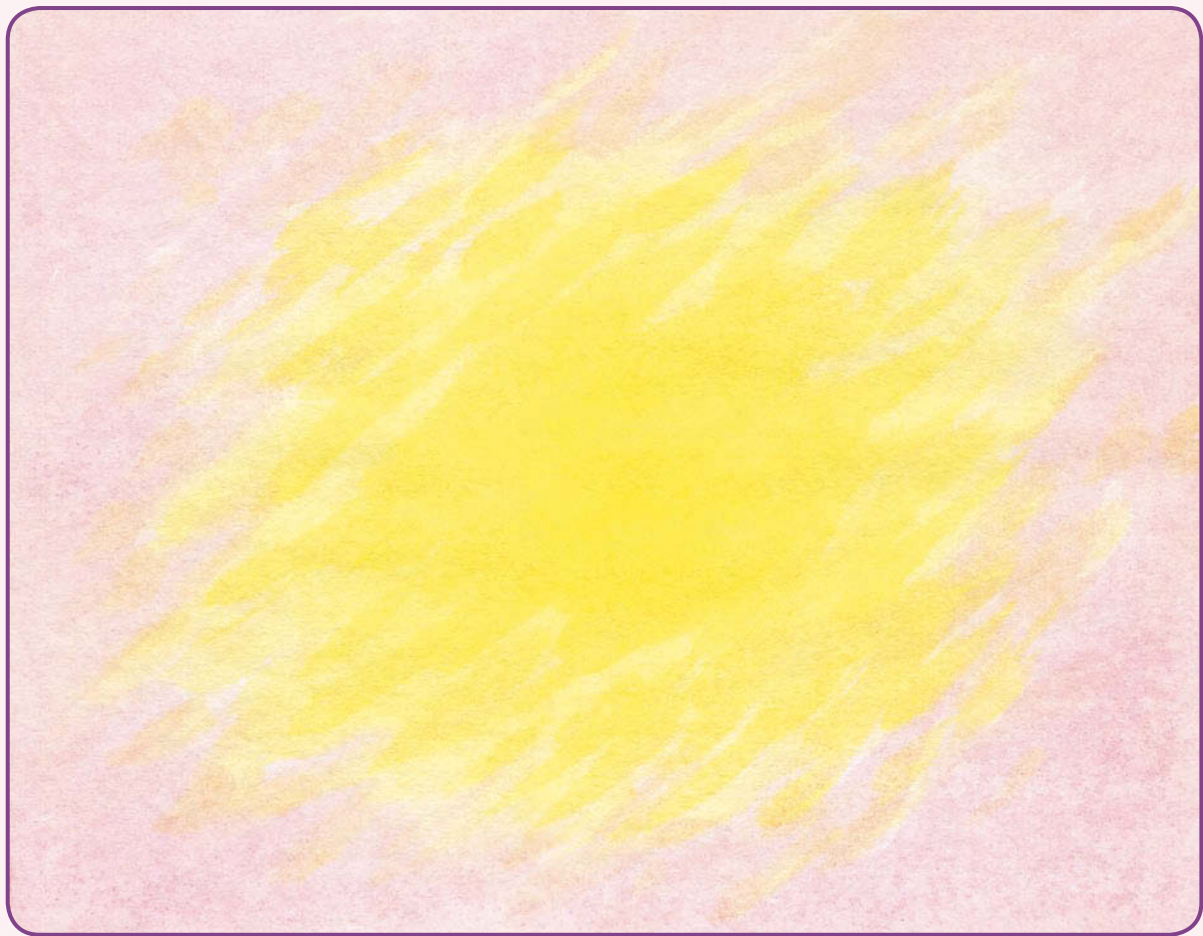

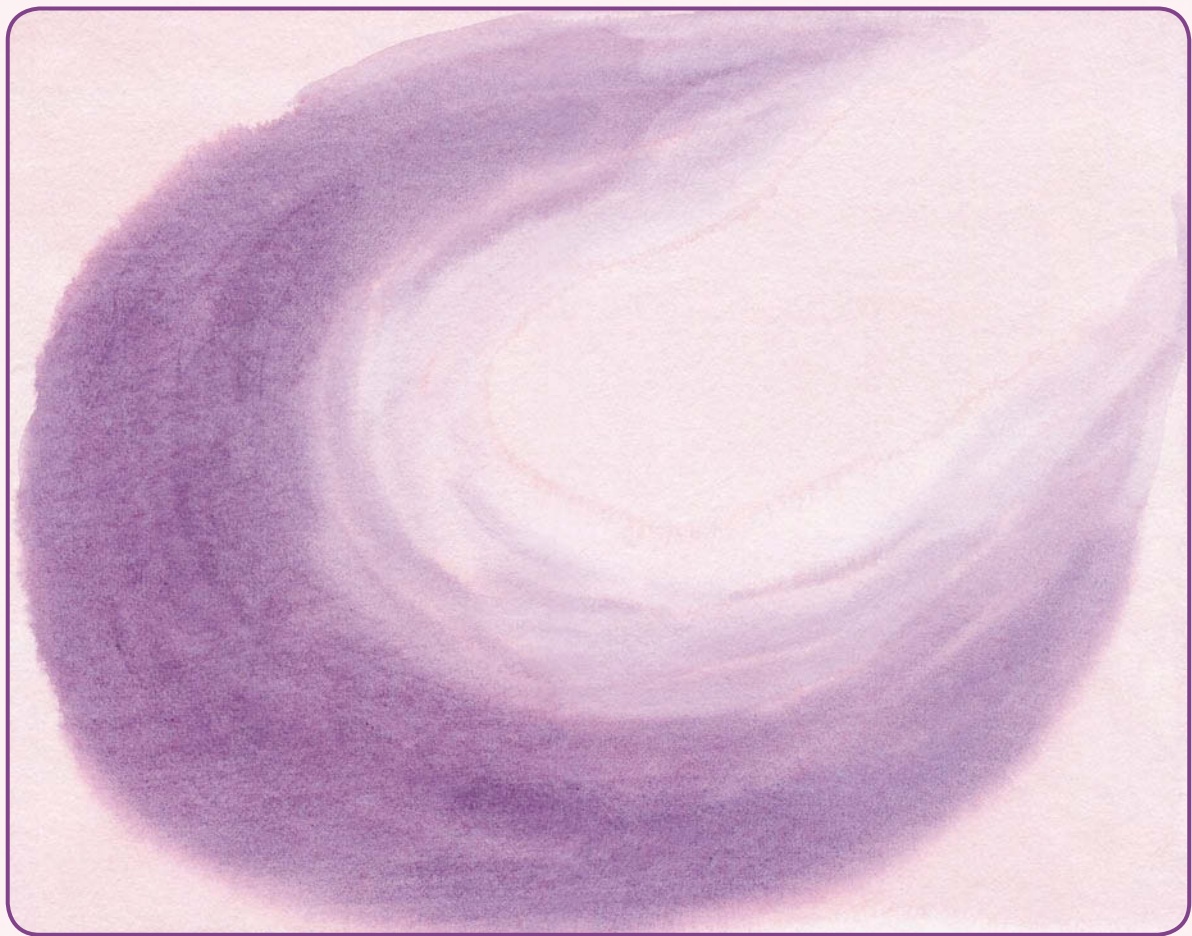
Green, the prettiest colors you will ever see.



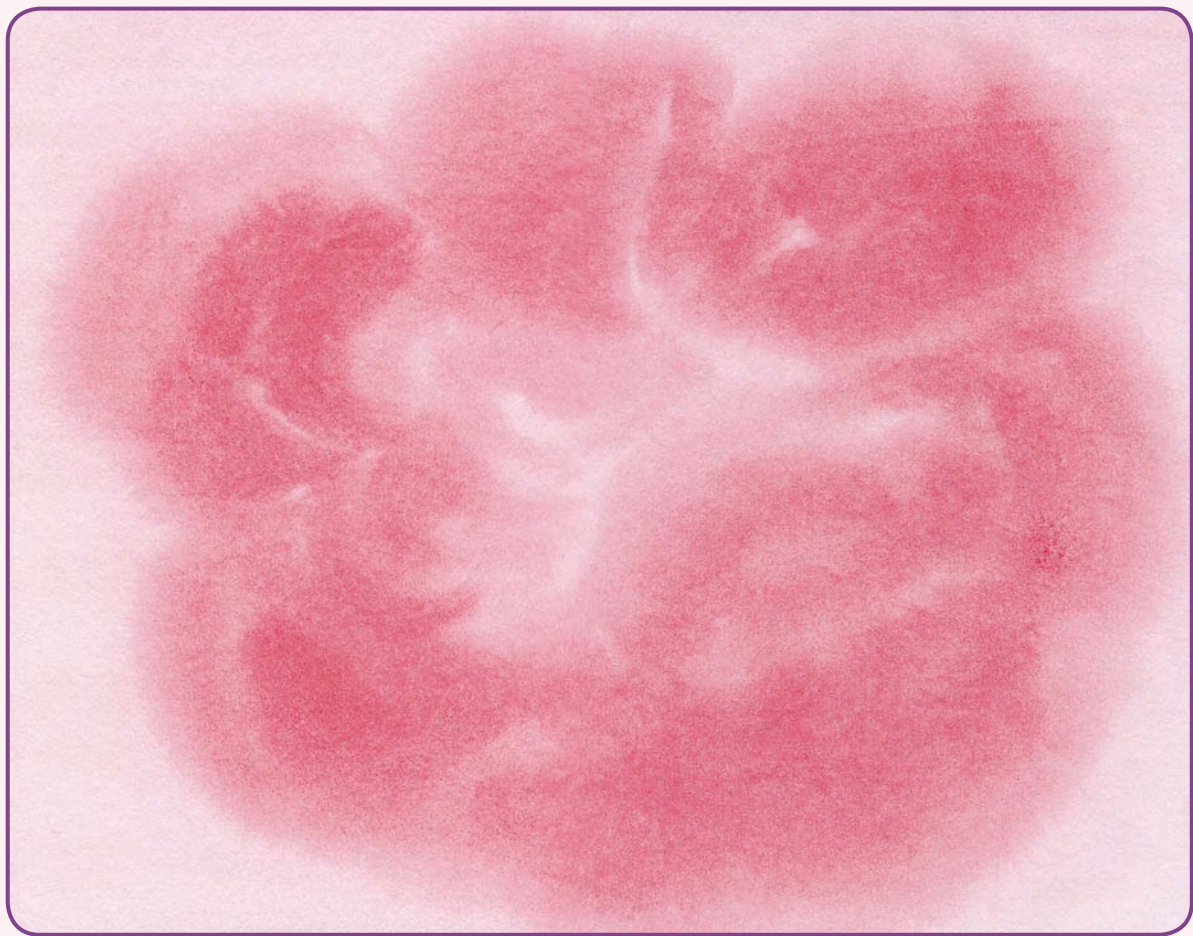

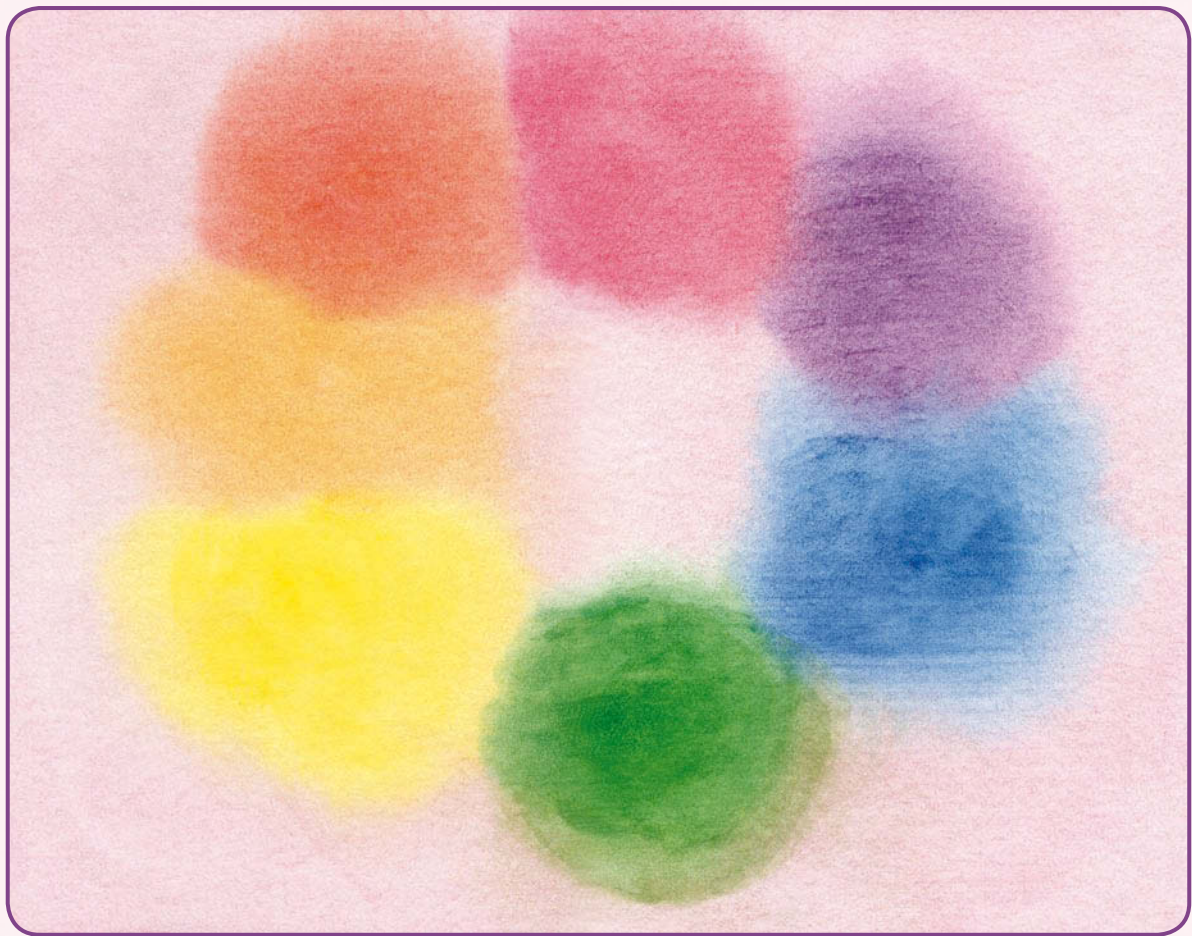

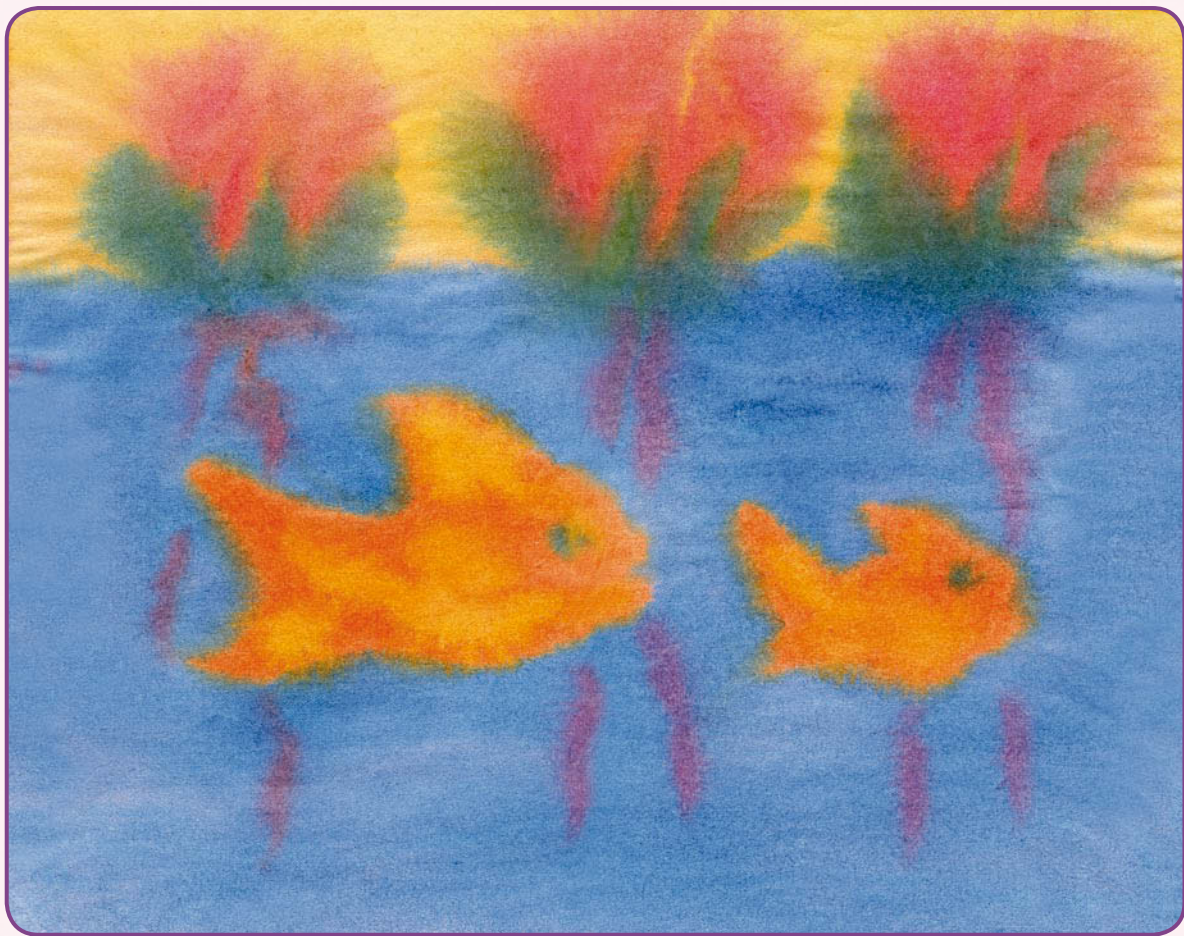
Magic Rose,

and animals all day,



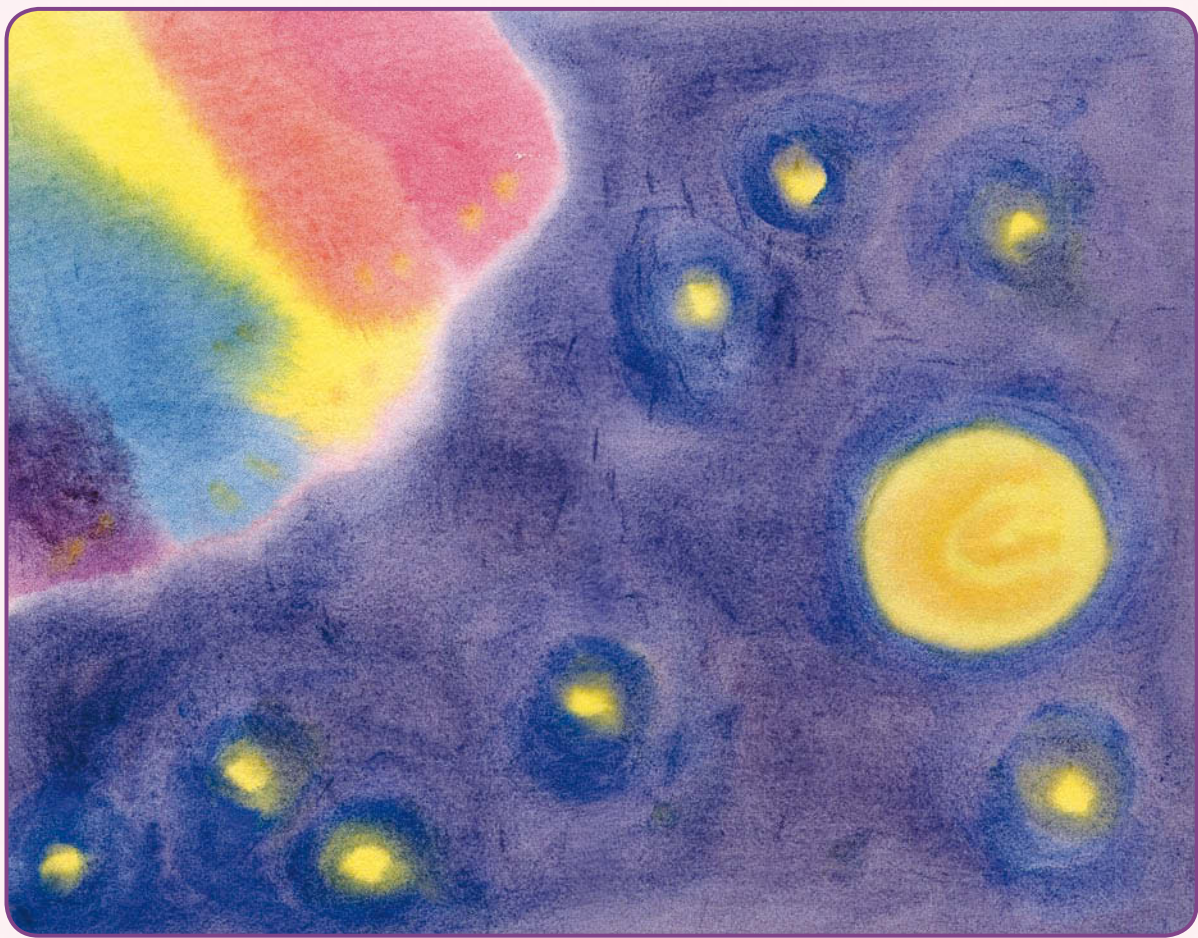
they tickle the children who come out to play.
